NEW FORMAT

What: A two day regatta with participation open to all skippers and crews of sailing craft, regardless of size, rating and club affiliation or non-affiliation. On Saturday the boats will race from Buffalo to Point Abino and on Sunday, the boats race for the Mayor's Cup from Abino Bay to Buffalo Harbor.

Free Dockage: Free dockage will be extended at BYC's Point Abino Basin to participating sailboats. Your cooperation with the docking committee is necessary to avoid unnecessary inconvenience to slip holders.

Handicap Ratings and Restrictions: All boats that do not have a valid PHRF rating will be assigned a rating. Single-handed sailing is prohibited.

Other Accommodations: Saturday evening dinner is available for purchase and will be followed by live music. NOTE: beverages (alcoholic and non-alcoholic) will NOT be available for sale by the BYC; BRING YOUR OWN BEVERAGES. Complimentary doughnuts and coffee will be available on Sunday morning. After racing on Sunday the outside grill menu will be available at the BYC Porter Avenue Clubhouse, plus open dining will be available to all participants in the Club's dining room beginning at 4:00 pm.

Trophies: One entry fee, two trophies! The trophies for Saturday's races will be awarded Saturday evening at Point Abino. The Mayor's Cup trophies will be awarded Sunday evening at the BYC Porter Avenue Clubhouse.
