At Point Abino things are progressing towards reopening in May. The north catwalk sections have been replaced, waterlines have been connected on the south docks, the floating docks have been reinstalled and stone is being added to the south berm drive. The day ranges & lights are being fabricated for replacement,

we extend our appreciation to Dave Nieman and PC Timothy Hunt for their contribution towards completion of this project. Thank you to Jeff Hayes for fabricating the welcome sign replacement and spearheading this task. All in all, the Point Abino station under the guidance of our operations manager, Captain Ruth Sparks who says she plans on having this facility operational by the beginning of the boating season. At Porter we too are moving forward towards the reopening of the

The outer wall north docks have been ordered for replacement, but due to prior commitments, Kropf, the manufacturer of our docks, will not have them ready for installation until mid-August. Through the cooperation of members owning slips in the inner basin we are accommodating those members directly affected, by suggesting relocating to Point Abino, late launchings, or even possibly moving to another marina for the season. Through the combined efforts of Fleet Captain Ed Gawarecki and RC Doug Bienko it looks as if we have found a home for all our Porter basin members. Quotes are still being received for other damages incurred after the October storm, such as the catwalk, electric for the docks headed by PC Robert Gage, and fence replacement just to name a few. The rafts holding our FJ's (Flying Junior) sailboats used for boating education are being reconstructed under the leadership of Roy Jordan. The floating docks and moorings have been reinstalled, with appreciation to Joe Gelsomino and RC Doug Bienko. Through the combined efforts of many members and individuals we too are moving forward to the 2020 boating season. A huge thank you goes out to all our volunteers! Our clubhouse building weathered the storm only sustaining minimal damage. New awnings and some minor alterations will prepare our building for the summer season too. During our winter shutdown we were able to make some needed maintenance improvements so that your club will once again be the jewel you are so proud to be a member of.

Our second obstacle/challenge is the novel Coronavirsus (COVID-19) and how it has affected your Club. First of all, the health and safety of our BYC members and staff is our top priority. This virus is frightening, we don't know where it might be hiding or even who might be a carrier. It is the Buffalo Yacht Club's commitment to doing our part to slow the spread of CO-VID-19 by practicing social distancing, therefore the normal operations of the clubhouse and restaurant have been suspended temporarily. 


Yacht Club Issues Edition Of Binnacle

Monthly Paper Schedules Races

The Buffalo Yacht Club has issued to members the first edition of the Binnacle, a newsy, interesting club paper which will be published once a month during the yachting season. Carl E. Nagel, chairman of the publication, will be assisted by Harry J. Elwood, Frederick F. Geibel, Peter Stetler and Edward E. Tunmore.

The bulletin dists racing schedules of keel yachts for the summer season. At 9 a. m. Saturday, July 15th, boats will race to Point Abino, thence to Port Colbourne for a clam bake, and then back to the point. On July 22d, there will be an overnight race to Port Maitland and from August 12th to the 19th, there will be an invitation race open to all seaworthy cabin keel boats on the Niagara River and adjoining waters of Lake Erie. Boats will race to Maitland and vature.

From September 2d to the 4th another overnight race is scheduled. This one will start from Point Abino at 2 p. m., boats sailing to Port Maitland where they will stay overnight, then on to an overnight stop at Dunkirk, and back to the Buffalo Canoe Club at Bay Beach. At 9 a. m. Sunday, September 10th, there will be a power squadron race, the course to be announced at a later date.















