throughout the building. New concrete slabs were added to the area between the locker rooms and the bridge. The Point Abino Station was put back together again in anticipation of a May reopening, and this too received needed improvements like a new day range and lights, along with a new WELCOME sign and new stone on the south berm. A new WiFi system was also installed at the Point this year. Our Canadian slip holders reported that the grounds were beautiful this year.

Back at Porter, our takeout service was ramped up and continues to be highly successful. It was a summer marked by making do and compromises we would have deemed unthinkable a year ago. Limited dining returned to the clubhouse and many of the traditional boating events took on a new look also. Both the Junior and Adult Sailing Programs saw extreme positive growth. 
