Fleet Captain Donna Atkinson's comments:

Well, 2022 certainly went out like a Lion! The December storm created a large amount of damage to the Buffalo Basin and docks. We remain diligent in our efforts to have the Basin ready for our May 15th opening, doing everything to avoid obstacles that may prevent a full basin opening AND assure all members have a dock available for their vessel.

I want to thank all of the members of the Basin committee, as well as Doug Bienko, Dave Woollatt, Mike Barry, Craig Bruening, and Dan Ward for their immediate response to assist with the damage incurred. We were very fortunate to have a good weather day the last week of December when the ice had already melted and we were able to resecure the docks stored in the Basin.

A detailed list of all damage sustained has been compiled and reviewed with Chubb, our insurance company.

The key issues we have been focused on with them are the complete replacement of 1 of 2 fingers associated with the dock which sunk on the Navy side. The South Outer docks also require like-for-like replacement and will include the intermediate fingers to maintain consistency with all other outer wall docks.

As soon as insurance approval is received, Buffalo Marine is committed to reassemble, repair and install all docks. They will also be handling other miscellaneous Basin repair requirements, which they estimate can be completed within a 3-4 week period of time. O'Connell Electric has provided their quote for electrical repairs and ability to begin work.

All elements are in place so that when we have the OK to begin, we can do so without delay.


The Basin committee has also been researching options to repair or replace the Porter Avenue Steel floating docks. These docks were stored off-site and did not incur storm damage, but they do require attention. A number of options are being evaluated for review with the membership for repairing/replacing them over a period of time or all at once. I am honored to be the BYC Fleet Captain this year and look forward to warmer days ahead, as well as another great boating season!

Guest Columnist Kevin Arnold

I recently had the pleasure of speaking over dinner with David Johnson, Ted Johnson's father, who has been a member of the yacht club since 1964. Here are some highlights from our conversation.

How did you first join the yacht club?

I bought an 18' Seagull not long after moving to Buffalo and a friend of mine suggested I join. I thought there was no way the yacht club would want someone with such a modest boat but they were eager for younger members.

What was racing like back then?

Before the Buffalo Harbor Sailing Club was started in 1977, we raced at Point Abino on weekends. We would have weekend races to Port Colbourne and Port Maitland. We would race up on Saturday and have a big dinner and party and race back on Sunday. We also used to have a rivalry with the officers from the Navy Reserve next door. One year, they even brought up a crew from Annapolis to try and beat us but the BYC showed them how to race on Lake Erie. This ended up being The Great Race.

Have you raced the Erie Dover?

More times than I can count. My first was in 1968 in a '28 Starlight I had just bought. We started out way behind but ended up coming back and winning the race. We have a lot of fond memories and friends that we have made over the years on the Erie Dover.

What was your first boat?

A 12' Barnegat Bay Sneakbox that I bought for \$50. Ted's first boat, with a 13' beam, was wider than mine was long!

What are some club traditions that you miss?

Members used to put on skits that were very popular. I also really liked



the Harbor Lights parties in the summer when the boats from Point Abino would come down all decorated to the Buffalo Basin. The windows upstairs in the club used to open out, which is something I miss.

What is the biggest change you've seen in the yacht club?

It used to be a DIY club. There was a rail line that went down to the water to take boats in and out of the water. At the beginning of each season, everyone would be down working on their boats, helping each other out, and having a great time. When the rail line was taken out to build the parking lot, the club changed quite a bit.

What is the best thing about the yacht club?

Definitely the relationships with people. It is a great place to meet friends that like to do what we do. We like being on and around the water. Many of these same friends belonged to Sitzmarker (now Buffalo Ski Club) and after the season, we would ski all winter with them. This still happens today. The club has had a lot of characters and we have made so many great friends over the years.

You joined in 1964. What do you suppose the club will be like in 2064?

Exactly like it is now.










