

BYCF Boating Education Cell Phone Policy

Junior sailors are strongly encouraged not to bring a cell phone to the BYCF Junior Sailing Program. If sailors bring their cell phones to Junior Sailing, they assume all liability. All other electronic devices are prohibited at Junior Sailing.

We have always taken our sailors' safety, well-being, and experience —your children— very seriously. However, we also know we cannot do this without your help. With more and more children using the Internet, cell phones, and other technologies at younger ages, we appeal to you as parents to partner with us to ensure that your child enjoys the safest, most fulfilling Junior Sailing experience possible. Any sailor violating this policy will have their cell phone/device confiscated until the end of the day.

Cell phones are expensive and can get lost or damaged, and the physical Junior Sailing environment is not kind to such items. If a camper brings a cell phone to Junior Sailing, they will be asked to put their phone in their backpack powered off.
