### 1. Rules:

This regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, the Class Rules of the International J/22 Class Association, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

### 2. Eligibility:

This regatta is open to all J/22 boats as defined by the Class rules and possess a valid measurement certificate. There will be no sail, boat measurements, or crew weigh in during the event.

### 3. Schedule:

- Check ins are Friday July 20, 14:00 to 20:00 at the Buffalo Yacht Club.
- All boats must be in the water by 21:00, Friday July 20 and remain in the water until the end of the regatta unless a change is approved by the Regatta Chairman.
- Racing will be Saturday and Sunday July 21 & 22. There will be no limit to the number of races each day.
- The warning signal for the first race on Saturday July 21 will be 10:00.
- The warning signal for the first race on Sunday July 22 will be 9:30.
- No race will start after 14:00 on Sunday.
- Awards will be at the Buffalo Yacht Club on Sunday immediately following the haul-out of the last boat.
- Out of town boats will be given preference for haul-out at the close of the regatta.

### 4. Registration:

  - Non US Sailing Member \$210.00
  - Entry fee after July 14<sup>th</sup>. \$250.00

- Entry fee includes: registration, launching and retrieval, docking, trailer parking, 3 tickets for the internationally famous Raw Bar dinner on Saturday July 21. Additional dinner tickets can be purchased with your registration for \$45 per dinner.
- A completed entry form must be received by the Buffalo Yacht Club not later than 16:00 July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018, to avoid a late registration fee. Entries will be accepted up to the close of the check-in period with the payment of the late registration/entry fee.
- Bow numbers will be required and supplied at registration.

### 5. Scoring:

The Low Points Scoring System, Appendix A (RRS), will be in use. One race will constitute a regatta. If six or more races are completed, a boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes Appendix A.4.

### 6. Prizes:

Prizes will be awarded for first through third place.

**7. Sailing Instructions:**

Sailing instructions will be available at the time of check-in, also may be available after 7/14/18 on the web site listed below.

**8. Racing Area:**

Racing will take place on Lake Erie, Buffalo, New York.

**9. Radio Communications:**

Unofficial information may be broadcasted on the VHF radio, channel 79.
